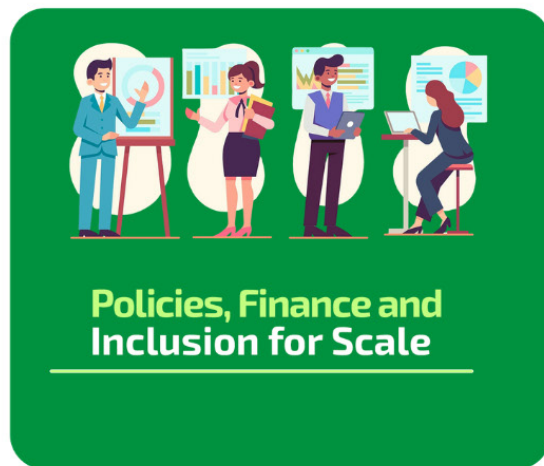

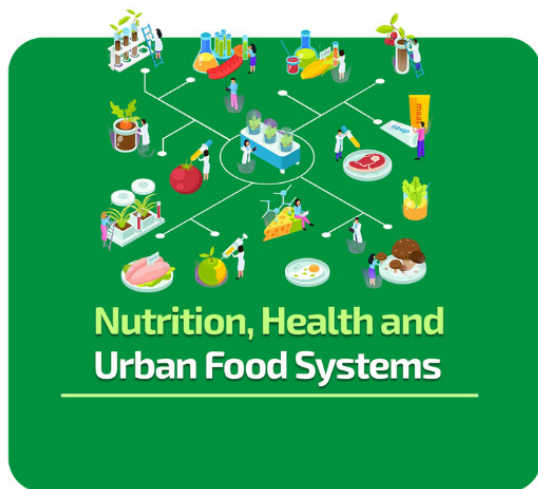

## Event Overview

The Africa Agriculture Science Week (AASW) serves as a premier platform for advancing dialogue on agricultural progress and innovation across the African continent. It provides a space to reflect on achievements to date and to strategize Africa's priorities for the next three years in this critical sector.

The event brings together stakeholders through high-level dialogues, plenary presentations, side and bilateral meetings, and an exhibition space, fostering collaboration, knowledge-sharing, and forward-looking strategies to drive agricultural transformation.

Running in parallel is the FARA General Assembly (GA), the highest decision-making organ, which guides governance and strategic directions. These events are internationally recognised for convening approximately 1500 to 2000 African and global leaders to debate issues, share knowledge, and showcase innovation.

# Event Overview

**1.1** To drive agrifood growth and transformation in Africa to meet the AU's objective of reducing dependence on food imports, while increasing agrifood output by 45 per cent and mobilising US\$100 billion in investment by 2035

**1.2** Using the AASW event to set up and facilitate collaboration across all farming platforms ranging from small scale and medium scale farmers to more extensive and intensive commercial farmers

**1.3** Using the AASW to create the necessary workshops and discussion platforms to connect investors, innovators, and farmers

**1.4** To set up a one-stop-shop, must attend agribusiness platform that includes **high-level plenaries** dealing with some of the continent's most pressing agricultural issues as well as a **state-of-the-art expo** showcasing the latest agricultural technology to increase production on the continent

**1.5** To promote and **facilitate Intra African trade** in the agriculture sector by matching commercial and emerging farmers with buyers and Agri processors from across the African continent as well as from beyond its borders

**1.6** To facilitate necessary high-level discussions between the AU, farmer interest groups, innovators, and private business investors to work towards an inclusive and workable model that will underpin and ensure the successful implementation of the that will be accepted by all agricultural interest groups

**1.7** And ultimately to create wealth and jobs; improve food and nutritional security; improve resilience to risks, notably climate change and pests and diseases; and achieve all these in an **environmentally sustainable manner**.

The 9th Africa Agriculture Science Week is co-organized with the Presidency of Nigeria through the Federal Ministry of Agriculture and Food Security and the Agriculture Research Council of Nigeria. ### The African Continental Free Trade Agreement (AfCFTA)

- Following the African Union's launch of the African Continental Free Trade Agreement (AfCFTA) in 2019, the AASW through its objectives provides a huge opportunity for the continent to take advantage of its enormous agriculture and food market which the World Bank projects to grow to USD 1 trillion per year by 2030. In performing its mandate, FARA is responding to this development by designing and facilitating interventions to ensure that Africa's agriculture are adequately supported by investment, science, technology, and innovation. These interventions include:
- **The Common Africa Agro-Parks (CAAPs) programme:** a mega initiative of the African Union Commission to create regional industrial hubs and corridors for major agricultural commodities. The AASW will be used as a platform for interaction with private businesses alongside discussion workshops on the CAAPs programme and its implementation.
- **The Africa Agribusiness and Science Week (AASW).** This is a continental event aimed at strengthening linkages between agriculture, business and research/innovation to improve the competitiveness of agribusinesses on the global stage and to ensure that investments in innovation are relevant to the needs and opportunities in the agribusiness domain. The Africa Agriculture Science Week is planned for July 2026. As stated above the event will feature the following:

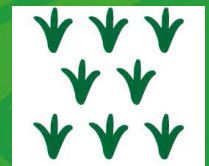

# 1. Implications of Waves of Technologies on Agricultural Development and Food Security

Africa's position in global research and innovation remains constrained by low investment in research and development (R&D). While global R&D spending averages about 2.2% of GDP, with leading economies investing between 3% and 5%, Africa has only marginally improved to around 0.45%. This is reflected in the continent's share of global patents, which remains below 1%, indicating weak innovation and commercialization capacity. This gap directly affects agricultural transformation and food security. Limited R&D investment results in weak development and scaling of locally adapted technologies, low mechanization, and slow uptake of climate-smart and soil health innovations. As a result, agricultural productivity across Africa remains well below global potential.

However, experiences from countries such as Kenya, Morocco, and South Africa show that targeted investment in research and innovation can drive meaningful progress. These examples highlight the need for increased investment, stronger coordination, and effective translation of science into practice. The 9th Africa Agricultural Science Week provides a critical platform to advance a more coherent and impact-driven agricultural research and innovation agenda for the continent.

## 2. The Agribusiness, Investment and Innovation Platform

The Agribusiness, Investment and Innovation Platform will provide a dynamic space for private-sector actors, investors, agribusiness leaders, innovators, and development partners to engage on practical opportunities to transform Africa's agrifood systems. Organised in collaboration with the [Nigerian Economic Summit Group \(NESG\)](#) and affiliate partners, the platform will promote business-to-business, business-to-government and science-to-enterprise exchanges. It will showcase scalable innovations, investment opportunities, market linkages, youth entrepreneurship, and strategic partnerships that can drive resilient, competitive and sustainable agrifood systems in Africa, while positioning AASW9 as a leading convening space for agribusiness dialogue and collaboration.

## 3. High Level Science & Partnership Forum

With Lessons from the FARA-led Biennial Science and Partnership for Agriculture Conference (SPAC), the High-Level Science & Partnership Forum will be a key side-convening of AASW9 and the 10th FARA GA, providing a high-level platform for learning lessons, policy dialogue, and strategic partnership building around Africa's evolving agrifood systems agenda.

This will promote a structured, bottom-up approach to agenda setting by drawing on national and regional perspectives to identify pressing agricultural challenges, technological gaps and emerging priorities.

The Forum will connect science policy and practice, while fostering collaboration among research institutions, governments, development partners and the private sector to shape responsive research agendas and accelerate innovation for resilient, inclusive and sustainable agrifood systems in Africa.

## 2.1 Main Objectives of the AASW

FARA believes that Nigeria, strategically, is well positioned to host the 9th edition of the Africa Agriculture Science Week (AASW) in Abuja. As Africa's largest economy and most populous country, Nigeria plays a central role in shaping the continent's agricultural transformation agenda. The country possesses vast agricultural potential, with over 70 million hectares of arable land, diverse agro-ecological zones, and a large and dynamic farming population.

Nigeria's agricultural sector contributes significantly to GDP and employment, serving as a critical driver of food security and economic growth. The country has made notable strides in advancing agricultural innovation, agribusiness development, and digital agriculture, supported by strong public and private sector engagement. Abuja, as the federal capital, provides a strategic hub for policy dialogue, regional coordination, and high-level stakeholder engagement across West Africa and beyond.

Nigeria also offers a compelling case for scaling science, technology, and innovation to address challenges such as food insecurity, climate resilience, and value chain inefficiencies. Hosting AASW in Abuja presents an opportunity to showcase best practices, foster partnerships, and catalyze investment in Africa's agricultural sector.

Drawing on experience, FARA considers that hosting the event in Nigeria will strengthen AASW's position as Africa's leading science-to-business platform, while enhancing visibility, participation, and impact across the continent. The country's strong institutional presence, infrastructure, and connectivity further support its suitability as a host.

FARA therefore seeks to collaborate with partners and sponsors to deliver a successful AASW in Abuja, positioning stakeholders at the forefront of transforming Africa's food systems. This comes at a critical time when Africa is working to reduce its significant food import bill—estimated at over US\$100 billion annually—while unlocking the immense potential of a rapidly growing agribusiness market projected to exceed US\$1 trillion by 2030.
